**CALL TO ORDER:** J Barg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:** Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**VISITOR –**

Kim Lewis stated she moved to May Township during COVID-19 and wants to learn more about how the township works.

Karissa Ramsey –was not present but requested Red River Trail be chloride. Email was presented to the board.

**EMERGENCY ROAD REVIEW PER STORM JULY 23 2021 –** J Barg reported a server thunderstorm came through May Township on July 23 2021. The board members did not meet together but did survey their perspective roads removing trees on the following sites:

53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SW – 1 tree

45<sup>th</sup> Street SW – 3 trees

116<sup>th</sup> Street SW – 1 tree

120<sup>th</sup> Street SW – 1 tree

65<sup>th</sup> Avenue SW – 4 trees (Mosquito Creek Road)

71<sup>st</sup> Street SW – 1.5 trees

53<sup>rd</sup> Avenue SW – 1 tree

**ROAD MAINTENANCE –**

**45<sup>th</sup> Street** – 45<sup>th</sup> Street needs to be graded.

**Sarah Drive SW** (31E) – Class 5 fill by creek maybe in-slope on curve.

**108<sup>th</sup> Street SW** (11E) by Gordon Martin – Re-build road. Culvert by 7 Mile Creek over hill ½ mile, east and west ends done. Center part needs to be re-built. Quotes will be requested.

**Chloride** –Chloriding was completed on July 5. Additional road request for chloride is in process but may take up to three weeks. J Barg stated he has been in contact with two agencies regarding chloride. Knife River charges \$1.50 a gallon and Tri-Mark charges \$0.96 a gallon.

**Culvert** – 100<sup>th</sup> Street culvert, crossing Mosquito Creek road – J Barg meet with DNR and Cass County Soil and Water. They suggest we wait to install a new culvert until the DNR survey of this piece of property is complete, October. If we wait there may be funding available to help the township pay for culvert.

**Brushing and Limbing trees** – The brushing and limb project has not been started. Discussion followed on who May Township could hire to complete this project ASAP. Mulching was brought up. J Barg will contact Enberg Logging to see if they would be interested in mulching for us.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Bridgeman Cemetery** – J Barg requested a work day at Bridgeman Cemetery this fall. The work day would include pruning trees, dead birch tree needs to be cut down, etc. Board agreed to call VanVickle Lawn Care service and see if they would be interested in cutting the birch tree down.

**Jake Braking** - M Breneman asked if there was anything May Township could do to stop the jake braking on Hwy 64. Discussion followed. C Converse stated it is a state highway and May Township has no jurisdiction. Mr Breneman will approach the State Highway Department for more information.

**District 11 Meeting** - board will meet at the township hall on August 25 2021 for a zoom meeting with District 11.

**ADJOURNMENT:** A motion by C Converse, seconded by M Breneman to adjourn meeting at 7:50 p.m. carried unanimously.
