CALL TO ORDER: J Barg called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Culverts – Culverts need to be added or replaced on the following roads:

Sarah Drive (31W) – 1 culvert (24 feet)

Debra Lane (32W) – 2 culverts by the turn around

61st Street (45S) – 1 culvert

124th Street (27W) – 2 culverts by Dean and Jill Johnson’s home

Flickinger Driveway (43N) – 1 culvert replaced or add an extension, shape ditch

The clerk will send a quote form to the following:

Lund, Swenson Ag, Ideal Construction, and Cal Disterhaupt

Project completion date is: 10.15.2022

Each road should be quoted individually as to account for township funding.

Contech Culverts – May Township has two culverts waiting to be picked up at Contech. They will ship up here for \$800. Discussion followed. Mark Breneman will get them here.

96th Street – Byron Township does not agree to having May Twp obtain fill from Byron’s Twp. portion of 96th St. west of Hwy 64. The fill for May’s portion will be taken on site.

108th Street – J Barg said he has spoken with Clint VanVickle who is planning on starting work the first week of August.

Debra Lane – Debra Lane needs a “no truck turn around” sign. A motion by C Converse, seconded by M Breneman to purchase a “no truck turn around” sign, carried unanimously.

Gravel Crushing – C Converse stated Homebrook Township is having gravel crushed at the Cass County Fairview pit at a reported lower price per yard than what May Twp had approved. Discussion followed. A motion by J Barg, seconded by M Breneman to let C. Converse enter a contact with Homebrook Twp’s contract crusher if it is a lower price per yard, carried unanimously.

Pillager Area Park Board – M Breneman stated the Park Board is not going to use the old pier at the Lake. He said it would cost too much to repair. Mr. Breneman also stated there is a resident who wishes to have it. A motion by C Converse, seconded by J Barg to give away the pier, carried unanimously.

Weed Grant – J Barg stated he has researched the use of the Weed Grant funds. He suggested May Township purchase a sprayer that can be loaded on the back of a truck, or ATV. Kings – KS100P7027. A motion by J Barg, seconded by C Converse to purchase a Kings – KS100P7027 with the Weed Grant Fund, carried unanimously.

Packer/Roller – C Converse stated the packer/roller for the grader is scheduled to be shipped August 10 and should be ready to be installed August 15 2022 by RDO.

A motion by C Converse, seconded by M Breneman to adjourn the meeting at 7:34 p.m., carried.
